## **Easing of Covid restrictions - at St. Mary's**

Last week we introduced a number of changes to our procedures at mass following the lifting of Covid restrictions

## **St Anthony's, Broadstone**

- There will be no change for the numbers allowed for the time being.
- As far as we are aware, no one has been unable to attend Mass who wished to at either church, as result of safety precautions being in place
- Singing will be allowed, using Parish hymn books which will only be used once a week, so present no increased risk, when handed out with gloves and returned to the bookshelf by the user.
- Post service sanitising will continue.
