CHURCH ROOF APPEAL

A landmark reached and more good news. As a result of your stunning efforts and kindness, the roof fund now stands at £50,409 (£42,269 already paid and £8,140 pledged / being paid monthly.)

We have also been able to complete roofing work on the hall entrance area and church internal drip protection and have met these costs from existing church reserves, with savings on the original estimates.

Putting these positives together, our hopes of achieving our target suddenly become more optimistic.

Huge thanks to you all for your donations and support.

We probably have another four years before the main church roof reaches the end of its serviceable life, but we now have real hopes of getting the funds in place. If you haven't had the opportunity to join the fundraising yet, but are able to give just £2.00 per week or £10.00 per month, we can achieve this goal.

Equally encouraging are the initiatives shown by many of you - such as the Christmas concert due to take place on 3rd December.

And, Ben Watt is planning a sponsored walk, probably in May 2022, walking to the 14 Catholic Churches in the BCP conurbation, a distance of 27 miles in a single day. The plan is for Ben to lead a small team on this epic walk. Two other walkers have also joined. Another 2 or 3 walkers would be ideal - plus loads of other support on the day.
