(Visiting every Catholic Cathedral in the UK)

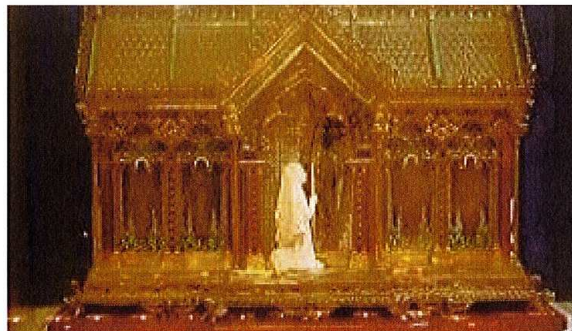
