Diocese Safeguarding Team

It's that time of year where the church is being targeted by these despicable criminals purporting to be a priest/bishop/religious sister who for whatever reason want cash urgently. The email they use is very similar to their normal email address or it's got some religious connotation in its title.

**Usually, there is a link to click or some other method in which monies can be transferred but it's always got some form of urgency or secrecy about the 'donation'.
Do 'we' normally ask for money like this? The answer is no.**

Another one doing the rounds nationally is about a scam pilgrimage to Knock where £500 and £1000 donations are requested to be sent to a Lloyds Bank Account.
Again, do we normally behave in this way? NO!!**

**Don't get caught. If you get any emails like this, let us know in the safeguarding team.
Always check check and check again.
The urgent nature of these emails is trying to force you in not doing what you would normally do in checking the legitimacy of the request.**

These criminals know how to push our buttons - we have to be wise to their methods.

Remember, each day, companies are being hacked and emails and passwords are stolen.

Always update and regularly change your passwords to your online accounts and don't use easily guessable passwords (like Password1 for example).
