We will keep you informed.

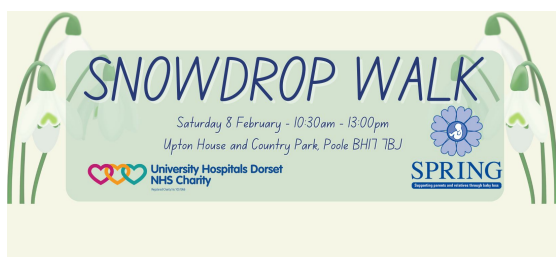
