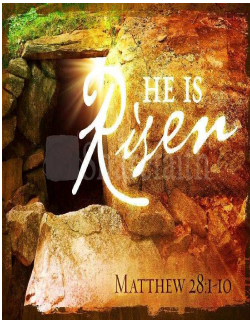

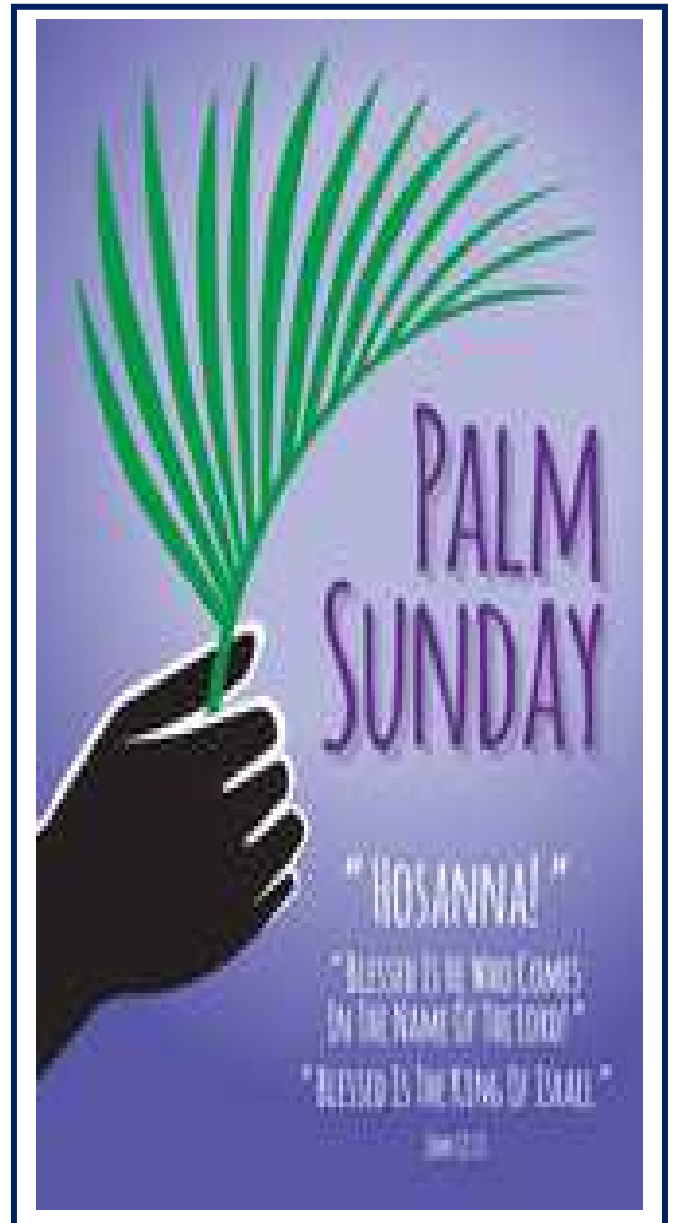

**29th April: Teacher-Mystic Teresa Higginson:** a new saint from our diocese?

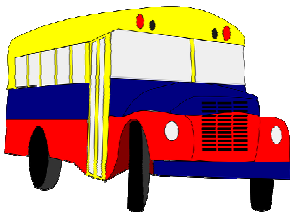
