CAFOD-TACKLE THE GLOBAL DEBT CRISIS

Last year, the Jubilee year, we collected 100s of your signatures & lobbied MPs about the global debt crisis. We know that with new wars impacting even more on poorer countries this year and the U.N. reporting that SUDAN is experiencing “the worst humanitarian crisis ever seen”, so the need for solutions to tackle fairer debt management are still more critical, As the UK takes over the presidency of the G20 later this year, we want to bombard the Prime Minister with a further petition encouraging the government to pass a UK Debt Justice Law, obliging debt financiers and international governments to follow a moral stance towards poorer nations and suffering populations. We will be collecting signatures after Masses on Sunday 28th June.
